The **Select Music Mode** pop-up window displays. Music Mode allows you to choose how your will stream and manage playback within the Harmony Music application.

Single Player and Multi-Player experiences are detailed in the next section of the *Music Library*, because the selection you make at this decision point will impact the display of the Player (formerly the **Now Playing** tab in Mood:Mix).

Music Library - Music Modes



The Now Playing view was the primary view for Mood Mix whereas the Music Library is the primary view in Harmony Music.

Harmony's **Music Library** is the starting point for viewing, creating, modifying, or deleting musical content. It is a catalog of your *Mixes*, *Stations,* and *Programs* and access points for *Schedules*. Dependent upon the **Music Mode** selected after selecting the Harmony's Music application, **Now Playing** displays in the bottom menu tray if **Multi-Player** was selected as the Music Mode. If **Single Player** is selected as the Music Mode, **Now Playing** is not a bottom menu option; however, the player displays at the top of the page as a toolbar in the *Music Library*.

Single Player Music Mode

1. Select Single Player as your *Music Mode* if your Company has a single device in a single-zone playback or if your Company has multiple devices and you want to stream from a single device.

2. Select a device from the device list.

The Player displays at the top of the page as toolbar in the Music Library.

Note: Every action taken in the *Music Library* will only impact the single player. In Single Player mode you can only access the Schedule your connected to, you can not see any other schedule to do that you would need to switch to Multi-Player mode.

Now Playing: Displays the Song Title, Artist, and Album in addition to a progress bar which shows the remaining time of the current song.

Play, Pause, Skip: Cannot Pause in Harmony; play/stop button - can skip up to 5 songs per hour.

Volume: Adjust on a horizontal rather than a vertical slider. Slide to the right to increase or to the left to decrease the volume.

Mix Board Toggle On/Off: Manage your **Mix Board** by opening a Mix from the My Mixes section of the *Music Library* in Harmony.

Add Program: Add Programs through the *My Programs* section of the Music Library in Harmony.

Element Blending: Manage your **Mix Board** by opening a Mix from the *My Mixes* section of the *Music Library* in Harmony.

Recently Played: Ability to Like (Heart button) or Block (Not Allowed symbol) in Mood:Mix; Block by track or artist for all or specific locations in Harmony.

Enjoy a streamlined Now Playing experience in Harmony Music.

- 1. Select Multi-Player as your Music Mode if you intend to work with all devices.
- To access the Player, select Now Playing from the bottom menu in Harmony (formerly Now Playing was the landing page in Mood:Mix and the first left menu option).

Now Playing: Displays the Song Title, Artist, and Album in addition to a progress bar which shows the remaining time of the current song.

Play, Pause, Skip: Cannot Pause in Harmony; play/stop button can skip up to 5 songs.

Volume: Adjust on a horizontal rather than a vertical slider. Slide to the right to increase or to the left to decrease the volume.

Mix Board Toggle On/Off: Manage your **Mix Board** by opening a Mix from the My Mixes section of the *Music Library* in Harmony.

Add Program: Add Programs through the *My Programs* section of the Music Library in Harmony.

Element Blending: Manage your **Mix Board** by opening a Mix from the *My Mixes* section of the *Music Library* in Harmony.

Recently Played: Ability to Like (Heart button) or Block (Not Allowed symbol) in Mood:Mix; Block by track or artist for all or specific locations in Harmony.

Zone: Harmony displays the Zone that is that is currently playing.

Schedule: Harmony displays available Schedules; can select between Schedules.

My Mixes

A Mix allows you to create your custom sound by blending 3 to 10 musical elements. Elements are micro-genres from different eras and styles. With Harmony, you can easily create new Mixes, modify current Mixes, or delete Mixes. Mixes are stored in your *Music Library*.

- **Mixes/My Mixes:** The **Mix** tab has moved from left menu pane in Mood:Mix to the *Music Library* in Harmony. **My Mixes** is where you can create, modify or delete Mixes.
- **Create a Mix:** Click the + Create a Mix button to start creating your own mixes.
- Create Mix Name/Description: Make your new Mix memorable by providing a unique Name for the Mix. Add a Description (optional).

- Music Search: Browse Mood provided genres or enter a Search term to filter music selections.
- Music Elements: Select 3 (minimum) to 10 (maximum) musical Elements to add to the Mix. All mixes associated with your account will be listed in your *Music Library*. From the Library, you can open mixes to edit or delete.
- **Mix Board:** Allows you to change how often a specific genre is played by increasing or decreasing the percentage slider.

Mood offers an extensive catalog of professionally curated Programs to expand your Music Library. Our Program content is regularly updated from artists and major labels. To get started adding or deleting Programs, browse your stored Programs in your Music Library.

- Programs/My Programs: Moved from the Select Music drop-down menu in Mood: Mix to a stand alone feature, My Programs, in Harmony's Music Library.
- Find More Programs: Select + Find More Programs 2 to get started browsing and adding new programs.
- All Programs: Displays all available programs or filters 3 Mood curated programs by matching your search criteria.
 - Search: Use the Search bar or the Genres drop-down menu to filter the All Programs view.
 - Sample Artist: Displays a list of sample artists.

Content Ratings: Review Content Ratings Levels. Content levels are rated using a scale of 1 to 4.

Level 1: Family-friendly, kid-safe, appropriate for all ages. Level 2: Appropriate for most and relevant to mainstream audiences, universal in appeal.

Level 3: Reflective of pop culture and current media trends, appropriate for many.

Level 4: Edgy, expressive and progressive, may contain content not suitable for some retail environments or audiences.

My Stations

My Stations is a new feature for Mood Mix users. Play and discover music you'll love by leveraging Harmony's recommendation algorithm.

Create customized music stations based on "seeds" of 1 to 10 songs/artists. Once Stations are created, they are viewable in the *Music Library*. From there, you can add, modify, or delete stations.

My Stations + Create a Station: From the *Music Library*, select + Create a Station to get started creating your own customized station.

- Add Seed: Select Add Seed to add up to 10 seed tracks/artists. For best results, select similar "seeds." If you select a Rock genre and a Classical genre, the algorithm may have trouble connecting the music.
- Artist/Song Title: Enter an artist or song title.

- Search: Select the Search button to view results.
- Add: Select + Add button to add the seed to your new station.

New scheduling features with advanced defaults in Harmony Music will help you set up a new schedule or alter a schedule with ease.

> The Schedules tab has moved from left menu pane in Mood: Mix to the bottom menu of the Music Library in Harmony.

In Harmony, click + Create to create a new schedule or click an existing schedule to edit a schedule. If starting a new schedule, users will Add Default Music. Previously users clicked on the calendar in Mix.

Select Add Scheduled Music button in Harmony.

In Harmony, select the radio button next to the music selection you wish to add to the schedule. Previously, users made selections from the Mix drop-down menu.

In Mood:Mix, Silence was a On/Off toggle. In Harmony, Silence is a music option that can be added to a new or existing schedule.

In Mood:Mix, music was scheduled through a calendar view. By clicking on the calendar, users could select Start/End Dates and Times. Users also selected days of the week for the schedule to Repeat.

In Harmony, users select the Calendar tab to open the music schedule. The calendar defaults to play 24/7 (all day, every day) via the ALL DAY checkbox. To edit the Start/End Dates, uncheck the ALL DAY box and select a Start/End Date. Use the Clock to set the Start/End Time.

Adjust the days by deselecting the days you do not want music to play.
